WHEREAS, Lung cancer is the deadliest cancer in the United States and the world; and

It has been shown that lung cancer screening significantly reduces mortality as the disease can be WHEREAS,

caught and treated earlier; and

Lung cancer is very fatal because it is often caught in later stages when treatment and prognosis are WHEREAS,

Only 5.7% of high-risk individuals are currently getting screened, which means thousands of lives are WHEREAS,

lost every year simply due to a lack of awareness; and

Maryland joins in recognizing the importance of educating the public on lung cancer, as well as WHEREAS.

emphasizing personal commitment for the need of early-detection of lung cancer through screening.
